













He published a guest column with Bloomberg, showing his baseball playoffs forecasting model. Dr. Ring has 3 conference presentations in the past 5 years. Using a faculty mentoring method of joint research, he has guided student teams to compete in the Fed Challenge for 3 consecutive years with the team from 2009 winning 3rd place in the 2nd Federal Reserve District (NY Fed). He is treasurer of the New York State Economics Association.</p>
<p>Wade Thomas</p> 	<p>Dr. Thomas is a tenured full professor. He earned his Ph.D. in Economics from the University of Nebraska-Lincoln in 1982. He co-authored the economics textbook, <i>Economic Issues Today: Alternative Approaches</i> that reached its 8th edition in 2005. Another textbook, <i>The American Economy: How It Works and How It Doesn't</i>, was published in March 2011. He produced an instructor's manual to accompany the former book and has produced both an instructor's manual and student study guide for the recent book. Dr. Thomas has a peer-reviewed journal article forthcoming and has several conference presentations to his credit. He also has more than a decade of regular attendance at AACSB conferences and those of its regional affiliate MAACBA.
