- Always consult with your advisor to prepare a schedule that best fits your needs.
- All related work for the major, prerequisite accounting and economics courses, and the general education requirements should be completed by the close of the sophomore year. (Note: FIT students may have to complete some General Education requirements in their junior year.)
- No 300-level accounting, business, or economics courses may be taken in the freshman or sophomore year.
- No 200-level accounting, business, or economics courses may be taken in the freshman year.
- If you are planning on doing an internship in your senior year, plan ahead to be sure you can finish all your required course work. BUS 319, Career Preparation, 1 s.h. is highly recommended before doing an internship.
- Retention in the major: Students must maintain a minimum GPA of 2.0 in the major. Students may be dropped from the major if they do not have a minimum 2.0 GPA in the major.
- A grade of "C" or better must be maintained in all major required course work.
