



RESEARCH SUPPORT SPECIALIST

The Research Foundation of the State University of New York College at Oneonta invites applications for a Research Support Specialist in the Biology Department. This position is a half time appointment funded by a three year National Institutes of Health R15 award studying molecular aspects of the heat shock response in mouse cell lines.

The successful candidate must possess independent judgment, discretion, and decision-making abilities necessary to carry out research activities. Duties include performing research projects involving cell culture, DNA procedures, and/or RNA procedures under the supervision of the Principal Investigator. Other responsibilities include preparation of solutions and media, lab organization and maintenance, maintaining supply inventories, updating lab protocols, and some supervision of undergraduate students.

Qualifications required: BA or BS in Biology, Biochemistry, or related field.

Preferred competencies include: Prior research, work, or internship experience in cell and molecular biology, genetics, or biochemistry. Demonstrated abilities in scientific writing, use of computer hardware and software, and/or statistics also desired.
