# “ All the World at Wembley: Britain in the 1920s ”

Dr. Anne Clendinning (Nipissing University) will be discussing the two consecutive summers, that of 1924 and 1925, Great Britain held the British Empire Exhibition at Wembley in north London. Part trade fair and part theme park, the event brought together the member nations of the British Empire to celebrate imperial unity and foster economic cooperation between the member nations. As such, the British Empire Exhibition serves as a microcosm that reveals a great deal about attitudes to empire, race and gender and the politics or post-war reconstruction in Britain during the 1920s.
