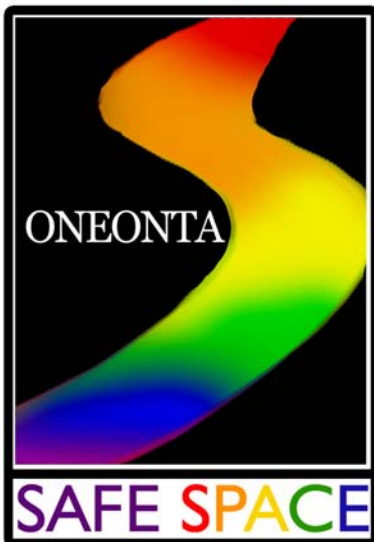
Special Training for Faculty and Staff only! Several people have asked for a faculty & staff “safe space”—please join us for a Safe Space session with no students!
